- 3 SECTION 1. DELISTING OF LESSER PRAIRIE-CHICKEN.
- 4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding any other provi-
- 5 sion of law, the lesser prairie-chicken (Tympanuchus
- 6 pallidicinctus), including each distinct population segment

- 1 of the lesser prairie-chicken, is removed from the lists of
- 2 threatened species and endangered species that are pub-
- 3 lished pursuant to the Endangered Species Act of 1973
